University of Mississippi considers academic integrity to be essential for each student's intellectual development. Assignments must adhere to APA format style and must include the proper citing of references. References to outside sources must be paraphrased and summarized appropriately.

Turnitin is a plagiarism prevention tool and detection software that assists students and faculty to ensure the academic integrity of submitted work. You will be required to submit your coursework through Turnitin. The software checks your work against all the published material stored in its database to see if your writing contains borrowed passages. The database includes but is not limited to websites, books, journals, and student papers.

Your instructor will inform you which assignments should be submitted to Turnitin. Submission to Turnitin does not take the place of your Dropbox, you will be required to submit your assignment to both areas. Your instructor will access your submissions and will advise you if there are any concerns. You will be able to view your submission results as well.
